## Details for the student bloggers

So your school or program has signed up for our international student blogger program — what next? Firstly, Study in the USA thanks you for joining and extends a warm welcome to our blogger program! Following are some of the details your student blogger will need.

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### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be prepared to honor the 3-month blog submission contract.
- Submission due dates occur twice a month — a total of 6 blog submissions will have been collected and posted by the end of the 3-month contract.
- If interested, bloggers will have the option to renew for another 3-month contract after each previous contract is completed.
- Create blog postings on life as an international student.
- Visit [our blog](#) for examples on some of the topics previous student bloggers have written about. Our editor is also happy to work with the blogger on topic suggestions.

### SUBMISSIONS SHOULD

- be between 500 to 1,500 words (max 2,500)
- include a short bio (i.e., “Saraya Student is studying communications at Blackwell University in Simmons, NY.”)
- include a current photo (can be taken with a phone, but be aware of lighting so the blogger’s face is visible and the background is not too overwhelming)
- have a clear, bold title
- be submitted as a Word, Google, or text document
- have all sources cited, if used
- be the blogger’s own, original work (if the blogger submits a plagiarized piece, Study in the USA reserves the right to terminate our contract with the student blogger, immediately)
